

History of Byers' Castle

Byers' Castle is situated just south of Ravenna, Ohio. Built by the John F. Byers family in 1905, the house is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. John F. Byers was a prominent industrialist and inventor, having started Byers Machine in Ravenna, Ohio. The home is a Queen Anne design featuring stained glass windows, beautifully restored hardwood floors, period chandeliers and sconces.

In 1951, Sam and Ruth DiPaola purchased Byers' Castle and raised their family on the twenty acres remaining of the original estate. The DiPaola family continues to occupy the home, and tends to the gardens, apiary, and orchard.
